


Policy BootCamp is an annual program by Vision India Foundation. It is a launchpad for policy enthusiasts.

Delegates

Policy BootCamp creates an ecosystem where some of the most passionate and talented young Indians come together to learn and engage with public policy.

Delegates for 2015 were selected from top universities in India and around the world. The delegates had backgrounds like law, technology, public policy, management, humanities, economics, sustainability, science, and entrepreneurship.

A total of 150 delegates represented a range of regions, languages, age, profession, and career interests. Some were students while others were working professionals.

The youngest delegate was aged 19 and the oldest 42. The median age was 24. A male-female ratio of 4:1 for this kind of activity was encouraging and points to better times. The delegates came from 20 Indian states.

Features of the Program

In this ecosystem, young minds interact with their role models and prepare to be the leaders of tomorrow.

The program has seminars, field visits, workshops, group discussions, case studies, parliament visit, and team activities.

The delegates work in a vibrant and energetic environment - immersing themselves into various programme components and intense discussions on various policy issues

Delegates also form special interest groups and deliberate on specific policy areas. They get an opportunity to discuss their ideas with experts from the field.

Some themes of discussion in 2015 were: political reforms, rural development, local governance, careers in public policy, gender, health, education, economics, banking reforms, entrepreneurship, energy, sustainability etc.

The connections that are built during these 21 days are those for a lifetime. Many of the past delegates are now working with the speakers who came to the BootCamp. Some found partners and teamed up to give shape to ideas which they held for so long.
